A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE REGION LAKES MANAGEMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING AN AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026

Whereas, the Lake Region Lakes Management District has advertised its intention to establish the ad valorem millage and to adopt a final budget for fiscal year 2025-2026, and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of the District has determined that an ad valorem tax millage of .3253 mills is necessary to fund the expenditures set forth in the budget and said expenditures are reasonable and necessary, and

Whereas, said millage is set at the rolled back rate of .3253, and represents a 6.68% decrease in property taxes adopted by the governing body of the District, and

Whereas, said District has properly noticed and held a public hearing on Wednesday, September 17, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. at District Headquarters and has heard and considered public comments on this matter all in accordance with s. 200.065, F.S., and

Whereas, a tentative ad valorem tax millage rate and budget were presented to the Commissioners and the public on September 3, 2025,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Lake Region Lakes Management District that the ad valorem tax millage rate for fiscal year 2025-2026 is established to be .3253 mills and that all such revenues are reasonable and necessary to fund the expenses of said District.
